KidVenture Ministry Team Choices:

In addition to training children how to read their Bible daily in their Disciple Groups, KidVenture trains and equips kids to live out their faith by using their spiritual gifts in ministry teams. Each week ministry team volunteers not only train kids to practice their ministry skills but to learn how to work as a team. Each month during the year, kids will be able to serve with their ministry team on Sunday mornings in the church as well as in the community.

At Community Outreach events the 4th-6th graders will lead and may be dropped off by a parent. 1st-3rd graders are welcome as participants and a parent is required to stay with the child. Kids will not be able to participate in Community Outreach events without a signed waiver on file.

Summer Missions:

Completed 4th-6th graders have the opportunity to lead Kidventure Camps locally and out of town during the summer. If your child signs up to participate for either or both the child and parent will be required to sign a commitment of participation upon registering for Missions. More info on Missions will be available at a later date.

What Is Expected of Your Child in KidVenture:

- be an example at church and in the community
- complete daily devotions and bring their book to Disciple Group every week
- memorize their weekly memory verse each week
- choose an area in which to train. (Stay in this area for the remainder of the year to be properly equipped for their chosen ministry)
- fulfill monthly service assignments. (Show up on time and be ready to serve)
- honor and respect KidVenture leadership
- dress modestly and appropriately at all times
- summer missions: each child attending summer missions will be required to exhibit the above qualities and complete their Disciple Group Handbook (quiet times) throughout the year to be eligible to attend

Child Commitment:
