**Thank you** for your personal interest in world missions! **During the campaign**, you will team up with national Christians and present the Gospel of Christ to neighborhood residents. Each evening you will participate in an evangelistic meeting in that very neighborhood calling men, women, children and even students to faith in Jesus as their only hope of heaven.

**After the campaign**, each new believer is followed-up one-on-one and discipled in home Bible studies. We provide the Bibles and literature for these new believers, but it is the Christian national who will provide the ongoing discipleship and encouraged to attend the new mission church in their neighborhood.

You will be a key part of this exciting and most rewarding ministry. It may be one of the greatest spiritual experiences of your life. There is **no limit** to what God can do through you as you yield yourself to the indwelling power of Christ!

## PASSPORT PROCEDURE

You can pick up your Passport Application at a local post office, or download them from the internet at [http://travel.state.gov/get\\_forms.html](http://travel.state.gov/get_forms.html) Passport renewal & change forms can be acquired in the same locations. Follow the instructions on the back of the form. It can take 6-8 weeks to get your passport, so it is **vital** that you apply for your passport as soon as possible.

The applicant must appear before your local passport agency. *(usually postmaster or clerk of court)* for the signing and witnessing of the application. *(Unless you are renewing or changing you passport, which can be done by mail.)* You can find your local passport agency on the internet at <http://iafdb.travel.state.gov/>

The applicant must submit the following to their local passport office:

- **Completed Passport Application** *(Instructions are included on application)*
- **2 passport pictures** *(2" x 2")* *(See application Instructions)*
- **\$85.00 Fee** *(\$55 passport fee {check or money order}, and \$30 execution fee {cash or money order. Varies with different passport offices} to be paid separately to the local passport office.*
- **Old Passport or State birth certificate** *(Must be a State or County issued birth certificate with their official seal. A copy or hospital record of birth WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED BY THE PASSPORT DEPARTMENT.)* *(A certified birth certificate must include your given name and surname, date and place of birth, date the birth record was filed, and seal or other certification of the official custodian of such records.)*
- **Photo identification** is required *(example, driver's license)*

Your completed passport application, two passport photos, \$85 passport fees, and State birth certificate, will be collected by your local passport office and placed in a sealed envelope, and forwarded to the nearest US Passport Processing Center. You should receive your passport within 6-8 weeks from the date that you apply for your passport.

### **Once you receive your passport:**

After receiving your passport from the U.S. Passport office, please send 2 photocopies of the portrait and signature pages *(Campaign Code must be noted on copies)* to NEXT Worldwide, a minimum of 30 days before departure. *(If a visa is required, you may need to have you passport 60 or more days before departure. Check with your campaign leaders for more information.)*

### **If you run out of time:**

- (1) Call a local private passport expediting service company *(find in Yellow Pages)*; **OR**
- (2) Call the Washington Passport Service Company at 1-800-272-7776.  
*(Additional fees are required for these services.)* *(You may also need a copy of your confirmed tickets or a travel itinerary from the NEXT Worldwide Office.)*

## SUPPORT RAISING - A BLESSING?

Many people already have been blessed by the Lord with the resources needed for a campaign. If God has not already given you the resources for the trip, He may desire to do some "faith building" in your life by having you raise some or all the funds. Although this is not something to be taken lightly, you can have a lot of fun mixed in with all the hard work.

Here are some suggestions to help you get started.

- STEP 1      PRAY. Express your total dependence on our Lord. Enlist others to pray with you.
- STEP 2      BEGIN WITH YOUR HOME CHURCH. Talk to your pastor or missions committee about how your church can help.
- STEP 3      MAKE A LIST OF PROSPECTS. Pray for ideas and list everyone who comes to mind. Include church friends, relatives, neighbors, school mates, club and civic contacts, Christmas card list. How about your doctor, lawyer, dentist? Do not leave people off your list, because you think they will not or can not support you. God may have other plans.
- STEP 4      RECORD AND PRIORITIZE YOUR PROSPECTS.
- STEP 5      MAIL LETTER & SUPPORT CARDS. See samples on following pages.
- STEP 6      MAKE FOLLOW-UP CONTACTS
- STEP 7      KEEP TRACK. As you receive gifts, have a simple way to keep track.
- STEP 8      SEND FUNDING TO YOUR CHURCH.
- STEP 9      SEND THANK YOU NOTES TO SUPPORTERS.
- STEP 10     SERVE GOD ON THE CAMPAIGN.
- STEP 11     SAY THANK YOU AGAIN AS YOU REPORT THE RESULTS TO YOUR SUPPORTERS.

## SAMPLE TESTIMONY

(Use this as a guide for writing your testimony. Feel welcome to use some of the same phrases!)

**Hello, my name is** Joe DeCitizen.

**I live in** the city of Dallas, Texas, in the USA.

**Before following Christ**, I tried to become happy by making money, going to parties, and living my way. But these things only made me empty. I knew I was sinning against God.

**I realized I needed** for God to save me from my sins.

**(How I became a Christian)** Then some friends showed me that the Bible says that God loved us so much that He sent His Son Jesus Christ to die on the cross to pay for our sins. Jesus was buried, and after 3 days God raised Him from the dead. The Bible says that those who trust in Jesus to forgive their sins will have eternal life with God. So that day, I put my trust in Jesus alone to forgive me of my sins.

**Today my life as a Christian is** full of joy, peace, and purpose. I know that God loves me and has forgiven me. Best of all, I know that I have eternal life with God.

**Would you like to know how you can have eternal life with God?**

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### Key Points to Remember when Writing Your Testimony

**'Before following Christ'**: Be *general* about your life before Christ. You don't want the hearer to dwell on your sins. Describing feelings is helpful (e.g., pain, loneliness, emptiness, uncertainty of eternity, etc.), but avoid needless sin details. If you say, "I was a [thief / etc.]", then the hearer may think, "I'm not *that* bad – I don't need Christ the way *s/he* does." General descriptions of sin have broader impact. If you say, "I was rebellious and sinned all the time," then the hearer may identify by thinking, "I bet *s/he* was a drinker, like *me*." And finally, don't spend 5 minutes on sin versus only 30 seconds on salvation and your new life!

**(How I became a Christian)**: Make sure this section gives the *gospel!* Your testimony may be the only chance for someone to hear it! *The gospel is*: we are sinners who are saved only when we put our faith in Christ, who died for our sins, was buried, and raised. Scripture does *not* say that we were saved by 'walking the aisle', or 'asking Jesus into our hearts', or other Christian-ese jargon. Be clear. Avoid 'churchy' terms.

**'Today my life as a Christian is'**: This section should show benefits, not problems! Tell of the joy, peace, and forgiveness Jesus gave you – instead of "since trusting Christ, I have had nothing but problems". If you really must mention the problems, a better approach would be, "After I trusted Christ, He has always given me strength and peace, even when I have problems." But *never* dwell on the problems!

## ADULT BIBLICAL UNITY ON A CAMPAIGN

(To be completed by traveling campaigner)

**THE GOAL OF UNITY.** The task of finally finishing the Great Commission is bigger than any one part of the Body of Christ. God wants to use the entire Body of Christ to finish this task. NEXT seeks to be an answer to the prayer Christ Himself prayed in John 17:20-21:

*I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word: that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me.*

**UNITY BASED ON TRUTH.** NEXT seeks to serve as a catalyst for spiritual, Biblical unity in the Body of Christ as we serve various parts of the Body to plant new churches. While we pray and work toward unity, we also are mindful of Paul's caution in Galatians 1:8, 9:

*But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed. As we have said before, so now I say again, if anyone preaches any other gospel to you than what you have received, let him be accursed.*

**STATEMENT OF FAITH.** Unity must be based on truth. Cooperation that results in a dilution or compromise of the essential truths of the Bible is ecumenism, not Holy Spirit-breathed Biblical unity. We seek to work with all those who believe in the following Statement of Faith:

**God.** We believe that the Godhead eternally exists in three persons--the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit--and that these three are one God, having precisely the same nature, attributes, and perfections.

**Jesus.** We believe in the deity of Jesus Christ, His virgin birth, sinless life, miracles, death on the cross to provide for our redemption, bodily resurrection and ascension into heaven, present ministry of intercession for us, and His return to earth in power and glory.

**Holy Spirit.** We believe in the personality and deity of the Holy Spirit, that He performs the miracle of new birth in an unbeliever and indwells believers, enabling them to live godly lives.

**Bible.** We believe in the divine verbal inspiration of the Scriptures. The whole Bible, in the original manuscripts, is without error. As the revelation of God, we believe the Bible to be the sole authority and sufficiency with regard to Christian faith and practice.

**Man.** We believe that man was originally created in the image of God. Adam fell through sin, and as a consequence of his sin, lost his spiritual life. This spiritual death, or total depravity of human nature, has been transmitted to the entire human race of man, the Man Christ Jesus alone being excepted. Thus every person is born into the world with a nature that is essentially and unchangeably sinful apart from divine grace.

**Salvation.** We believe that, due to universal death through sin, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless born again. Our redemption has been accomplished solely by the blood of our Lord Jesus. We believe that the new birth of the believer comes only through faith in Christ. No other acts, such as confession, baptism, prayer, faithful service, or manifestation of certain spiritual gifts, are to be added to believing as a condition of salvation.

## **ADULT CAMPAIGN CONTRACT**

*(To be completed only if 18 years or older)*

By signing this contract, I am indicating that I would like to participate in a NEXT Worldwide (*NEXT*) Church Planting Campaign, and I am committed to obtain all of the funds necessary to do so. I realize that all funds that I obtain for this campaign are considered as charitable contributions to my church (*a non profit organization*), and therefore are the property of my church, for federal income tax purposes to the extent permitted by law. Tax deductible contributions will not be refunded.

I realize that all checks should be made payable to my church and mailed to the church office.

If I am able to participate in the campaign, the campaign price, established by NEXT Worldwide, and any expenses incurred by NEXT Worldwide on my behalf for this campaign, will be deducted from my campaign account. I will submit:

- 50% of campaign price (after \$200 deposit) at least 60 days prior to the campaign departure date; and
- All remaining campaign price at least 30 days prior to the campaign departure date.

In the event that I do not participate in the campaign, any expenses incurred for me or on my behalf (*airline cancellation fees, deposits, etc*) will be deducted from my campaign account, and I will be responsible for any deficit. I will pay any deficit within fifteen (15) days following notice to me of the amount of such deficit. Any funds remaining that exceed \$200 in the my account, after all of the my expenses are paid, may be applied as a non-refundable deposit toward a future NEXT campaign before the end of the next calendar year. These funds will be moved to a pending campaign account. No interest will accrue for funds left in a pending campaign account. Any funds not used by the end of the following calendar year will be used to further the mission of NEXT. In the event that campaign funds raised exceed campaign costs by less than \$200, such excess funds may be used, by NEXT, to cover other campaign costs.

I am a Christian and believe that the Bible commands Christians to make every effort to live at peace and to resolve disputes with each other in private or within the Christian church (see Matthew 18: 15-20; 1 Corinthians 6:1-8). Therefore, I agree that any claim or dispute arising from or related to this Contract or any campaign in which I participate shall be settled by biblically based mediation and, if necessary, legally binding arbitration in accordance with the Rules of Procedure for Christian Conciliation of the Institute for Christian Conciliation. All such mediation and arbitration shall take place in Dallas, Texas. Judgment upon an arbitration award may be in any court otherwise having jurisdiction. I understand that these methods shall be the sole remedy for any controversy or claim arising out of this Contract or any such campaign and I expressly waive any rights I have to file a lawsuit in any civil court for such disputes, except to enforce an arbitration decision.

2. Remember that I have come to learn, not to teach. I may run across procedures that I feel are inefficient, or attitudes that I find closed-minded. I will resist the temptation to inform our hosts about “how I do things.” I will be open to learning other people’s methods and ideas.
3. Respect the host’s view of Christianity. I recognize that Christianity has many faces throughout the world, and that the purpose of this trip is to witness and experience faith lived out in a new setting.
4. Develop and maintain a servant’s attitude toward all nationals and my teammates.
5. Respect my team leader(s) and his or her decisions.
6. Refrain from gossip. I may be surprised at how each person will blossom when freed from the concern that others may be passing judgment.
7. Refrain from complaining. I know that travel can present numerous unexpected and undesired circumstances, but the rewards of conquering such circumstances are innumerable. I will try to be creative and supportive.
8. Respect the work that is going on in the country with the particular church(es) or person(s) with whom we are working. I realize that our team is here for just a short while, but that the local church is here for the long term. I will respect their knowledge, insights, and instructions.
9. Refrain from negative political comments or hostile discussions concerning our host country’s politics.
10. Remember not to be exclusive in my relationships. If my close friend or spouse is on the team, we will make every effort to interact with all members of the team, not just one another.
11. Refrain from any activity that could be construed as a romantic interest toward a national. I realize certain activities that seem innocent in my own culture may seem inappropriate in others.
12. Abstain from the consumption of alcoholic beverages, the use of tobacco, or any un-Christ-like behavior while on the trip.
